A cloisonné pin identifying you as an exclusive member of this program will be issued. Proudly wear your pin, ensuring your recognition and benefits at each Eichelberger performance.

As an additional benefit, you will receive 2 Free beverages of your choice at every Eichelberger performance.

You may purchase up to four pairs of premium seats.

Your yearly cost is \$1,000 for two seats payable annually or semi-annually. A commitment of three years is required.
